WHEREAS Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month raises public awareness for a lifetime of safe motorcycle riding;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, James Richards, Mayor of the Town of Lady Lake, Florida, do hereby proclaim the month of May of the Year 2012, as
