WHEREAS, the motorcycle is an energy-efficient vehicle that reduces fuel consumption, traffic and parking congestion; and

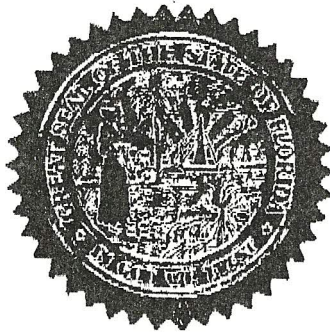
WHEREAS, the motorcycle has proved to be an important form of transportation for commuting, as well as touring and recreation both on and off the roads; and

WHEREAS, as a matter of safety, it is necessary to develop skills and an awareness of proper driving habits to handle these vehicles on the highways of our state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Lawton Chiles, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the state of Florida, do hereby proclaim May 1996 as

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AND AWARENESS MONTH

in Florida in recognition of the need for a greater public awareness of the motorcycle and its proper use on our highways.
